SPECIAL ADDRESS BY THE RIGHT REVD. THE DEAN.

“Let us now unite in reverent praise and thanksgiving for our brothers, the Officers and Constables of the Metropolitan Police, who in the Great War have laid down their lives for their King and their Country.

Members of the most renowned Police Force in the world, they had already served with honour at home. In days of peace they were the bulwark of loyalty and order : in days of war and national peril they cheerfully responded to the call of duty. They did their part nobly : they made the great sacrifice, in order to resist and overthrow the violence of an unscrupulous and ruthless foe. By their deaths they safeguarded mankind's most sacred possessions, freedom and justice ;

they protected the people's dearest treasures, the family and the home; they shielded the community from pillage and its property from rapine and destruction.

In Westminster Abbey we do our homage to the memory of those dear comrades who have fallen for us. One is taken and another left. We recall their names with regard and affection. May we who remain emulate their great example of loyal devotion, enduring constancy, and high discipline. May He who at the last great day, will reunite us with our brothers, make all steadfast in the performance of arduous and honourable duties; uncompromising in the resistance of every form of wrong; patient under provocation; gentle towards the weak and helpless; formidable to the evil doer; worthy upholders and staunch promoters of the great traditions inherited by this famous Force!"

O God, Who makest wars to cease in all the world, and by Whose mighty aid the power of our enemies has been overthrown ; guide, we pray Thee, at this time by Thy Holy Spirit the minds of those to whom Thou hast committed the Government of the nations, and prosper all counsels which make for the restoration of a rightful and abiding peace : that we and all Thy people being set free from the perils of war, may serve Thee henceforth in newness of life : through JESUS CHRIST our LORD. Amen.

O ETERNAL LORD GOD, Who holdest all souls in life ; we beseech Thee to shed forth upon Thy whole Church in Paradise and on earth the bright beams of Thy light and heavenly comfort ; and grant that we, following the good example of those who have loved and served Thee here and are now at rest, may with them at length enter into the fulness of Thine unending joy ; through JESUS CHRIST our LORD.
